A lot of folks remember when Cape Fear Valley Medical Center was half the size it is today. Back then we had about 200 physicians on the medical staff.

Today, Cape Fear Valley Medical Center has nearly 500 beds, and the medical staff has more than doubled to 550 physicians. That's a milestone achievement for any hospital.

And it's not just about sheer numbers. Just as important are the depth and breadth of our medical staff. With more than 50 different specialties and subspecialties, it rivals that of many academic medical centers.
